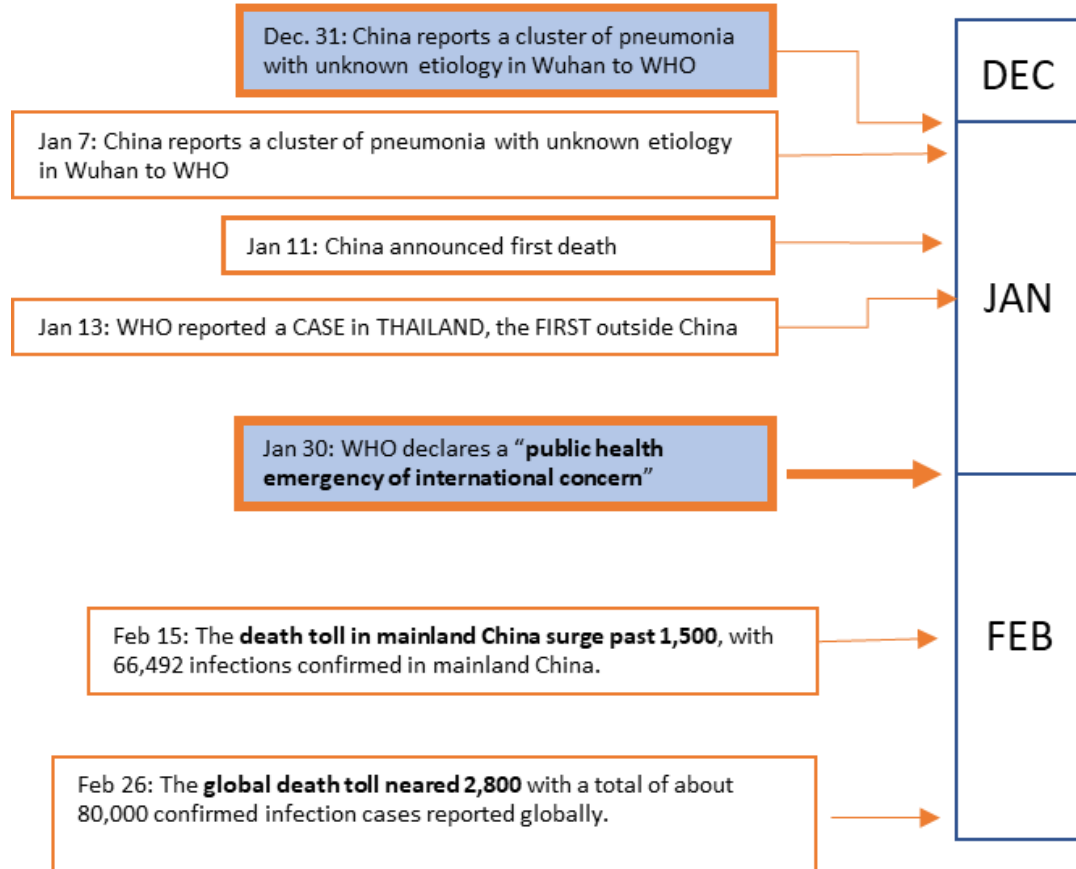

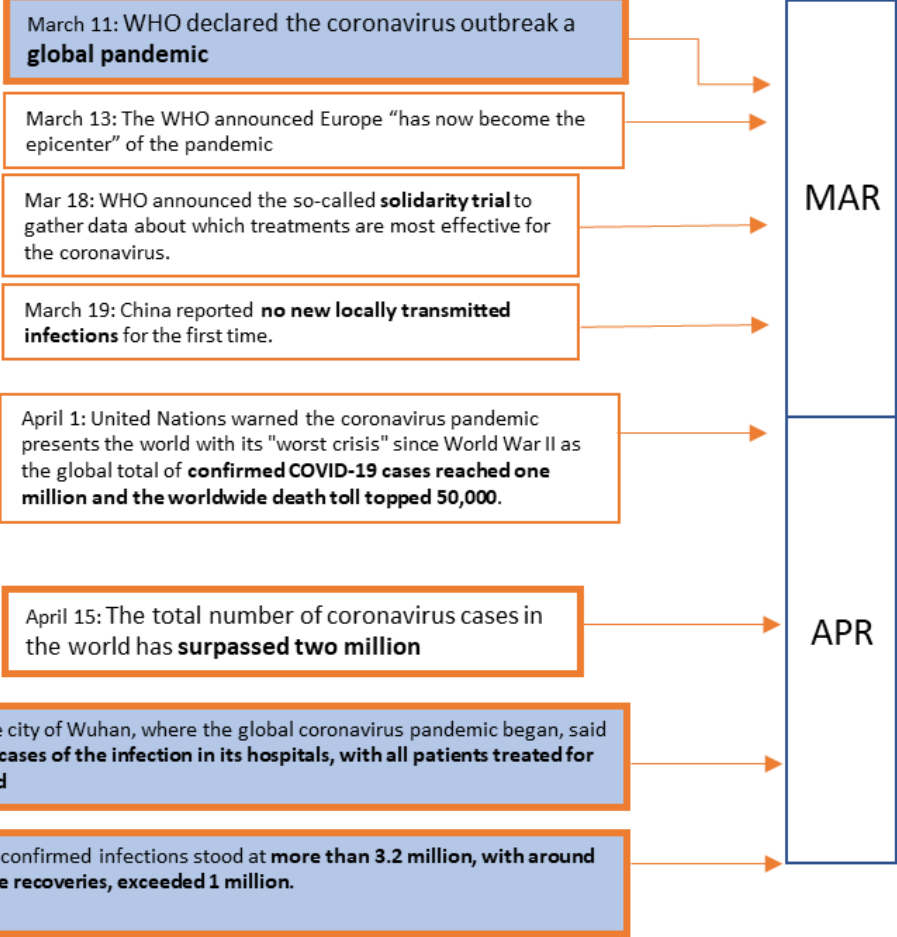

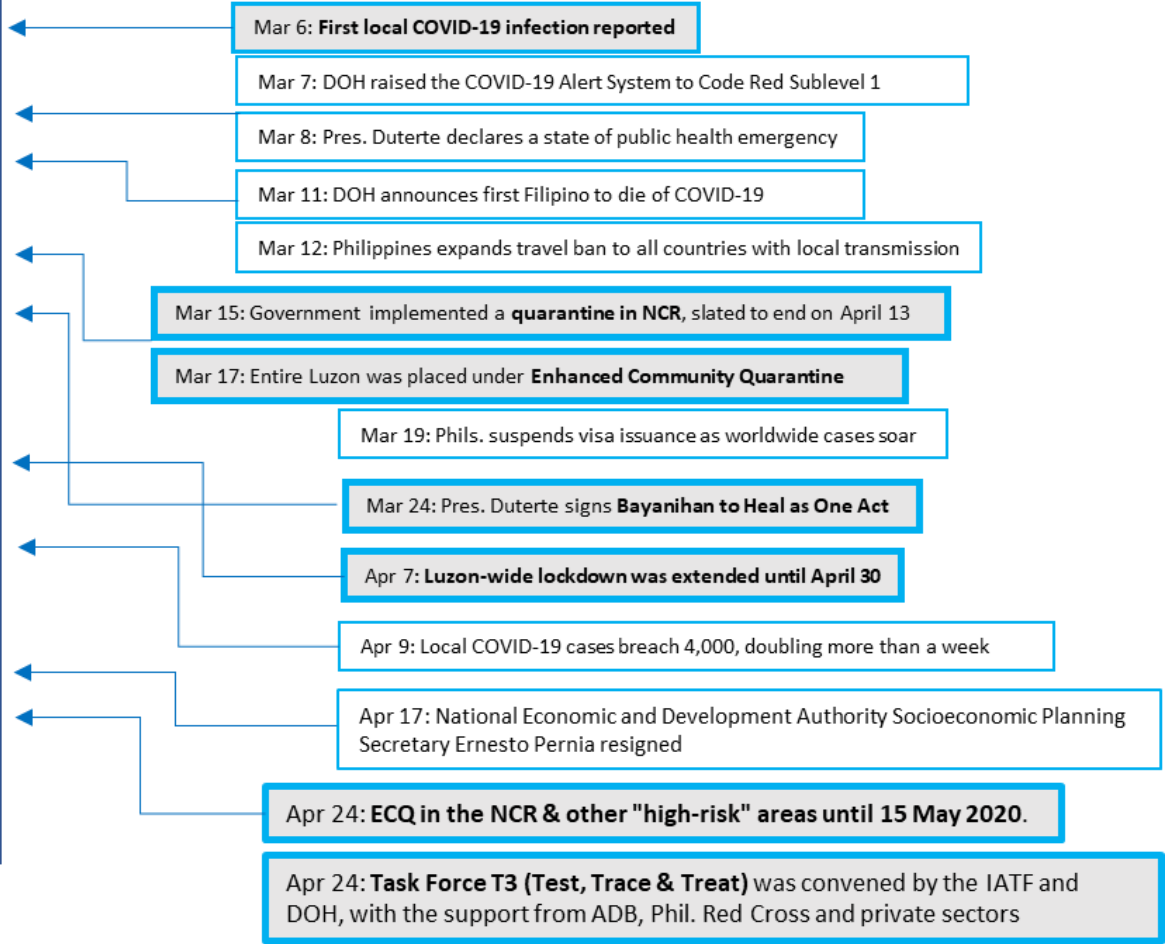

May 6: The WHO warned of the risks of returning to lockdown if countries emerging from pandemic restrictions do not manage transitions "extremely carefully and in a phased approach".

May 9: The number of novel coronavirus cases recorded worldwide surpassed **four million**, with 277, 127 deaths

May 3: DOH reported that the confirmed cases exceeded 9,000

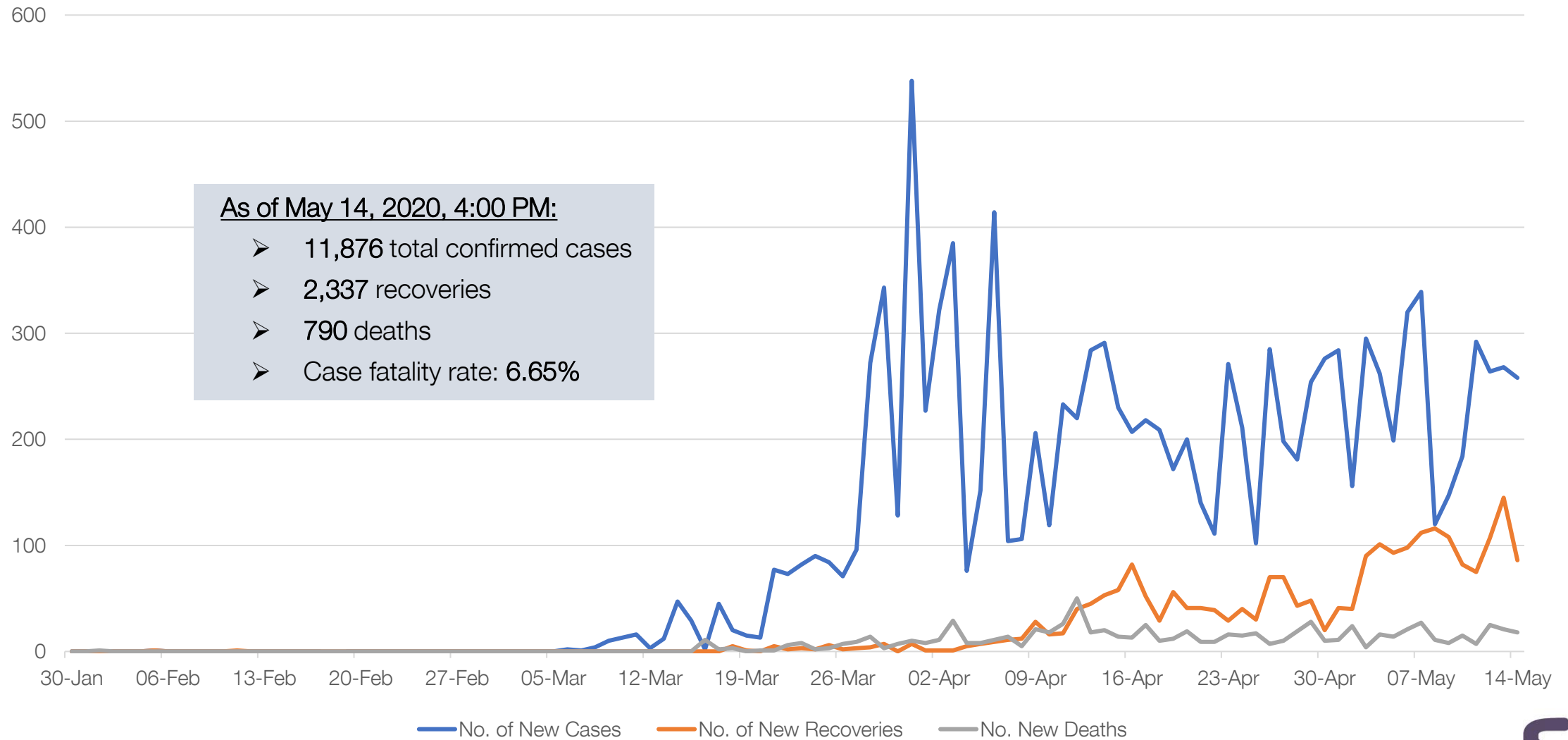
May 4: Congress resumes sessions, prioritizing measures addressing the impact of COVID-19

May 6: DOH announced total number of **confirmed cases reached 10,000**

May 11 : Total number of **confirmed cases breached 11,000 mark, 1,999 recoveries and 726 deaths**

May 12: Modified ECQ on NCR, Laguna and Cebu City; GCQ in selected areas until May 31
