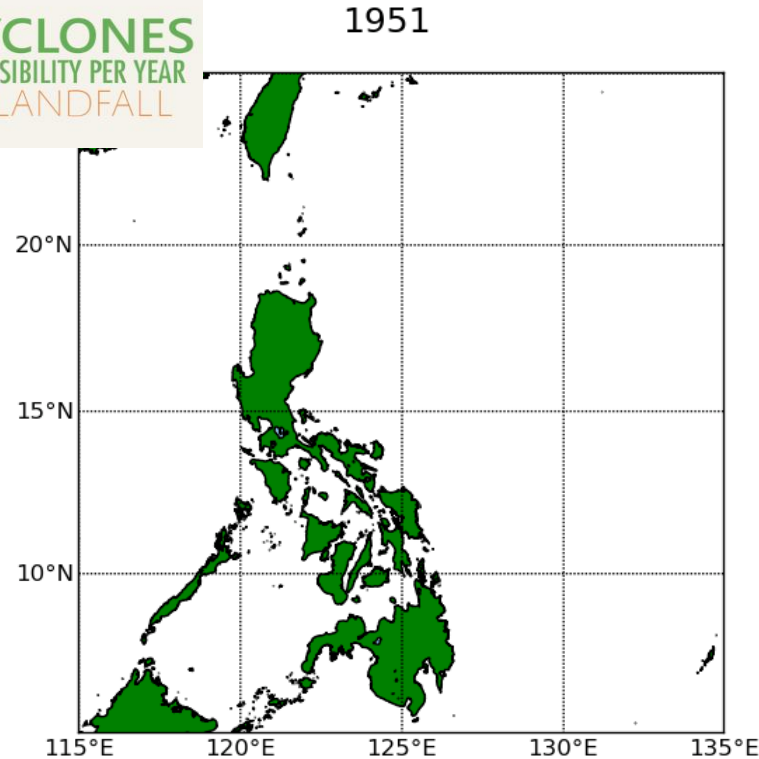

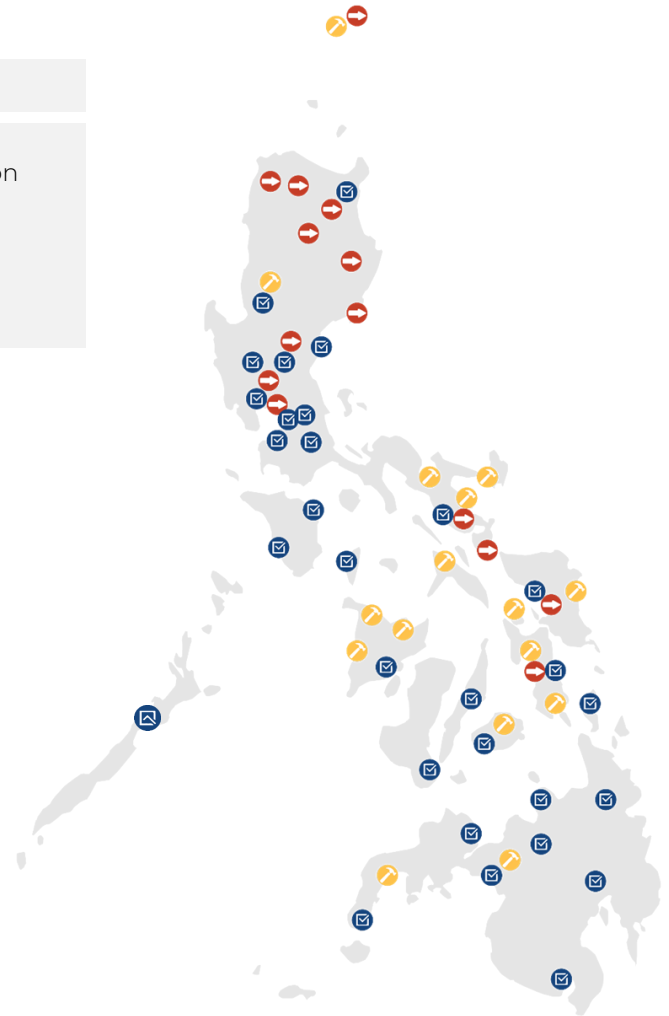


## OUR WORK

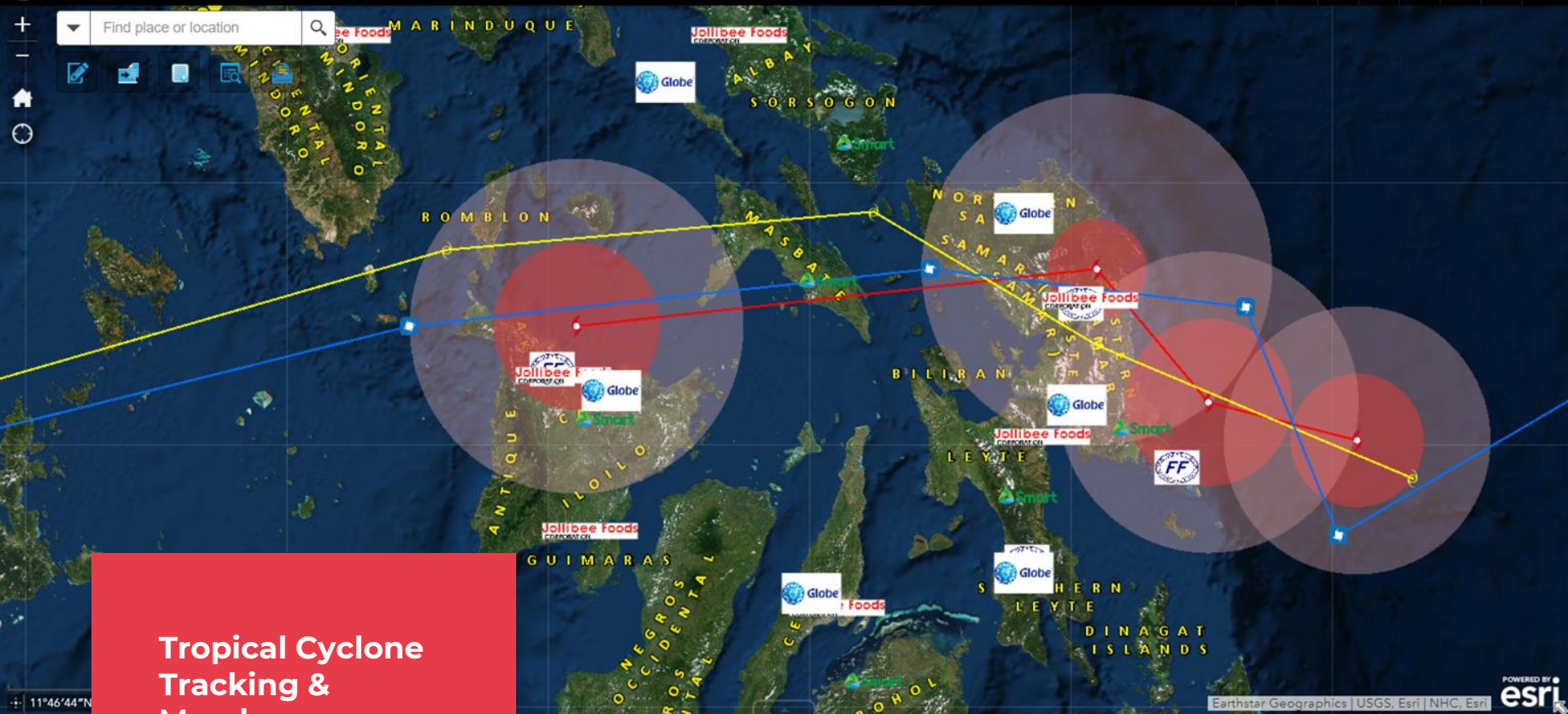




# PDRF OPERATIONS CENTER

The **PDRF Emergency Operations Center (EOC)** is the first private sector-led national operations center in the Asia-Pacific Region. Located in the Clark Special Economic Zone in Pampanga, the PDRF EOC uses advanced communication software and technology to monitor climate-related and natural hazards (hydrometeorological disasters, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, and pandemics), provide alerts and updates to the PDRF network, and coordinate relief and response efforts.

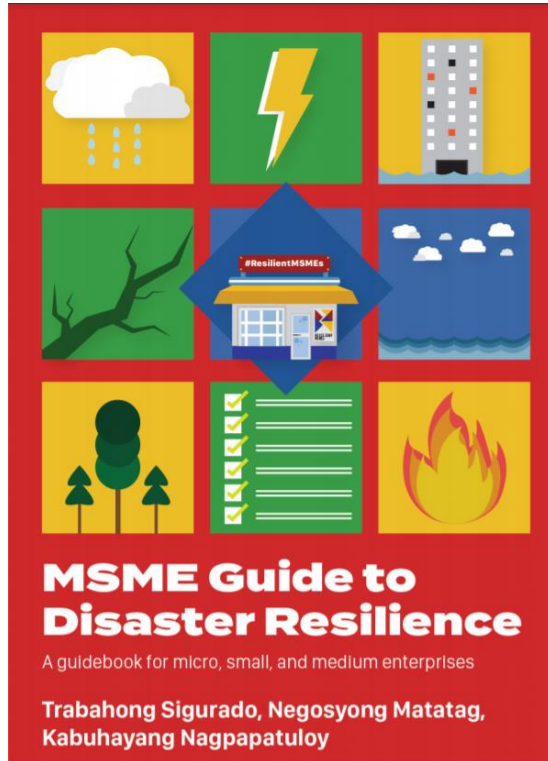

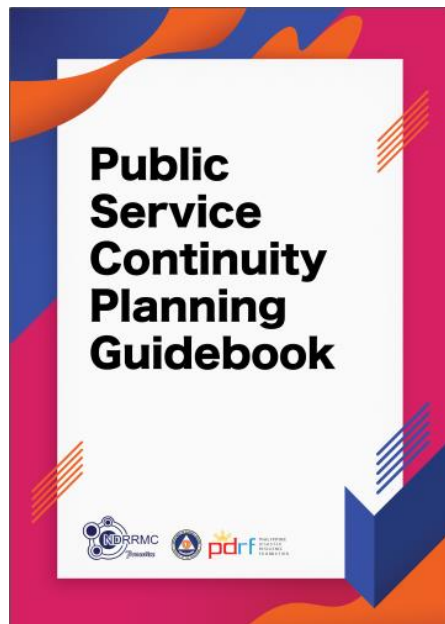
