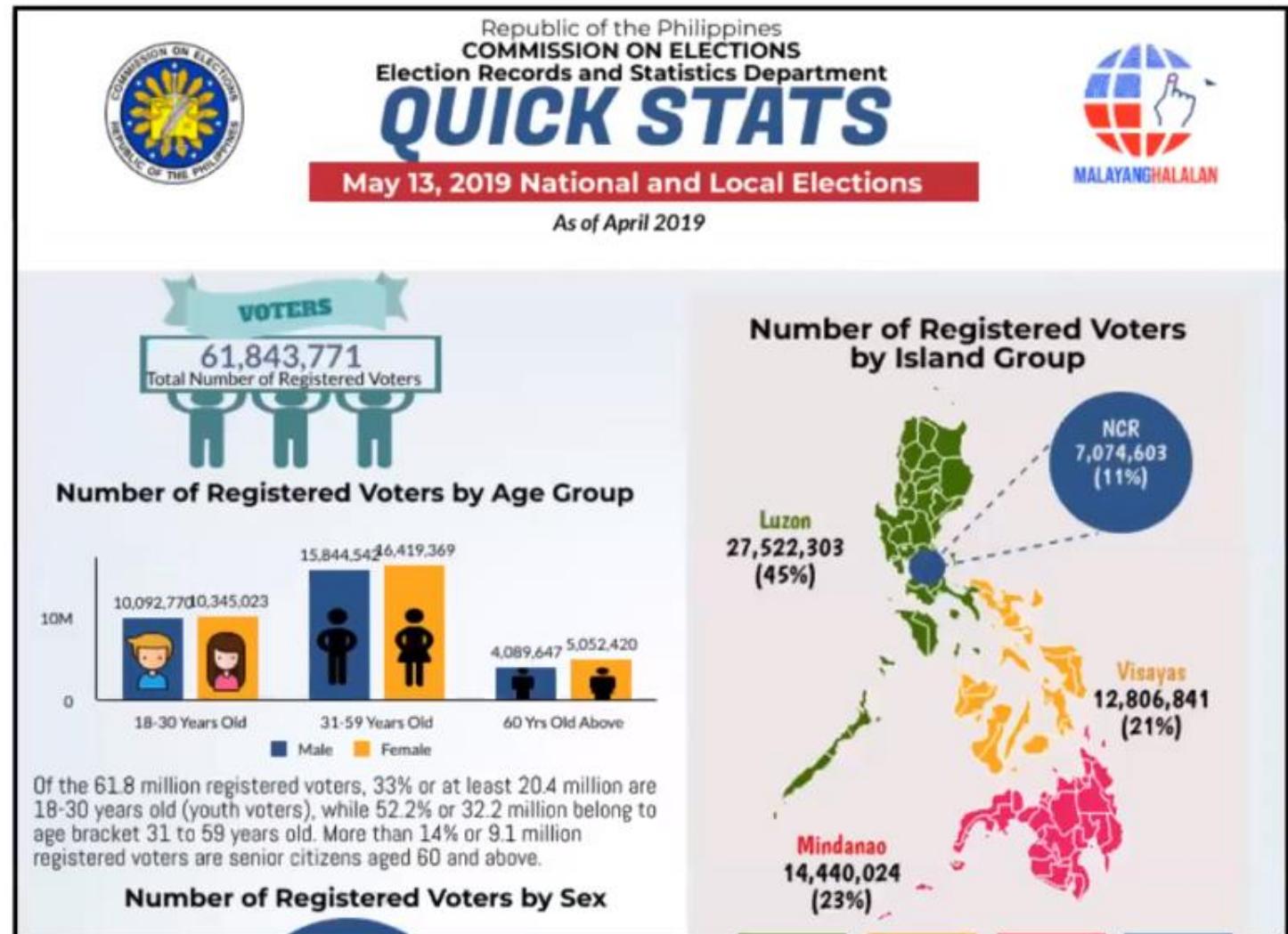

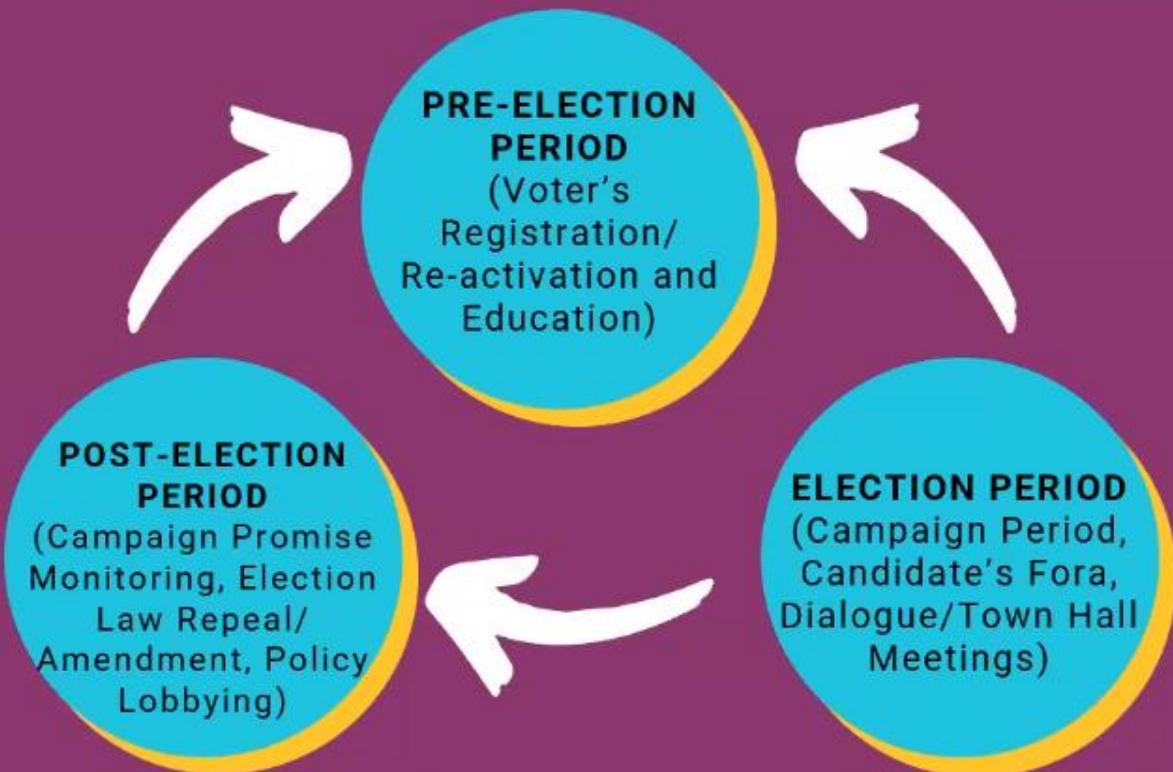

Pre-Election



- Voters Registration, Transfer, Reactivation, Correction of Entries
- Voters Education (*while addressing misinformation especially in digital platforms e.g. Facebook, Tiktok, Twitter*)
- Youth Agenda Building

Election Period



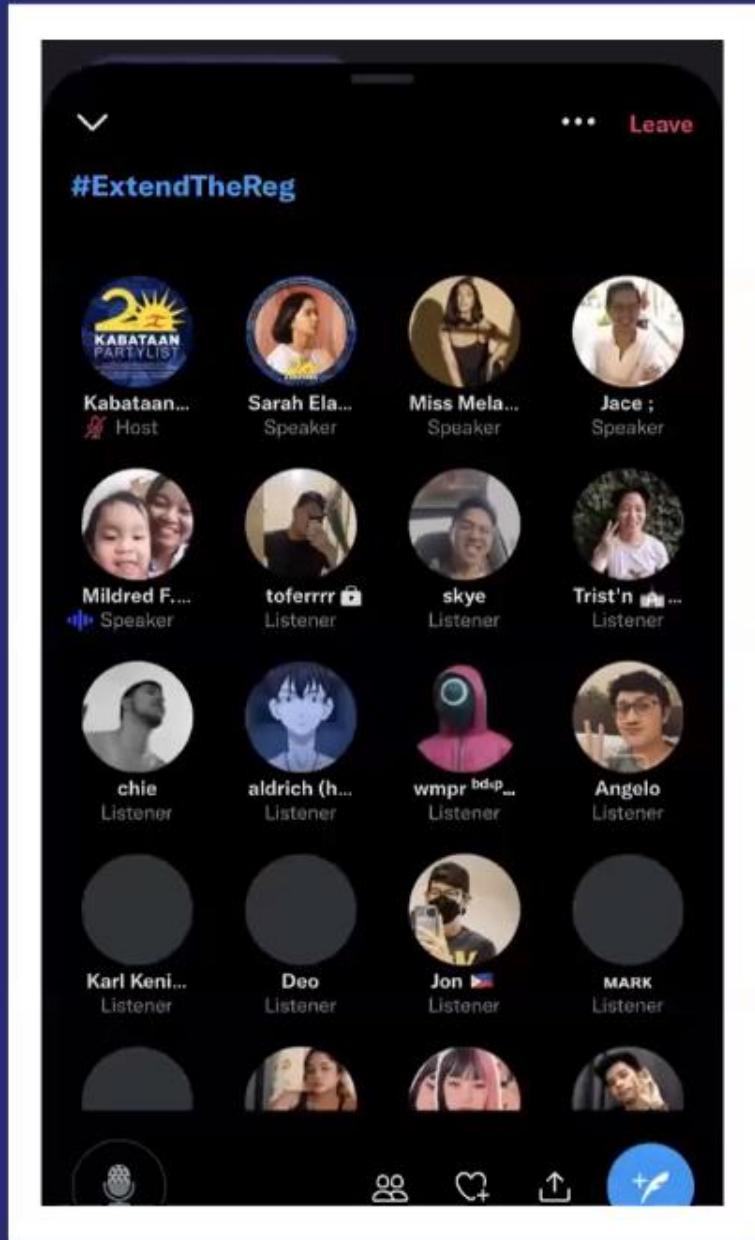
- Partisan/Non-Partisan Campaigns (issue-based)
- Engage in Candidate's Fora/Dialogue/Town Hall Debates/Meetings
- Election Monitoring Hubs (Local and National) – Violation of Election Laws/COMELEC Rules and Regulations #bantayboto
- Prepare Election Checklist, Show Up, and VOTE!

Post Election



- Review and Assessment – Campaign Promise Monitoring
- Lobby for Repeal/Amendment of Election Laws (*Harmonize Voters Registration Act with the Automated Election Law*)
- Empower and engage youth networks to participate in governance processes (Local Youth Development Councils, SK, LGU)
- Start them young - Sibika Hubs and Project Citizen

Voter Interference Policies

We also disallow:

- OFFERS TO BUY OR SELL VOTES WITH CASH OR GIFTS
- STATEMENTS THAT ADVOCATE, PROVIDE INSTRUCTIONS OR SHOW EXPLICIT INTENT TO ILLEGALLY PARTICIPATE IN A VOTING PROCESS
- EXPLICIT CLAIMS THAT PARTICIPATION IN THE VOTING PROCESS WILL LEAD TO COVID (OR OTHER COMMUNICABLE DISEASE) INFECTION
