




Democracy that relies on the distribution of material benefits or "patronage" to mobilize voters



Democratic Deficits

- 1 Issue of Political Dynasty incumbency advantage, political monopoly, and perpetuation
- 2 Issue of Political Parties weak parties, strong patronage; clans not parties; party-switching
- 3 Issue of Party List System mangled legislation, interpretation, and implementation; party-list failure
- 4 Issue of Money Politics campaign financing, spending, and monitoring

Proposals

Anti-Party Switching Act - prevent political turncoatism to strengthen political parties

2 New Election Code - bring electoral administration into the 21st century

3 Constitutional Convention - imperfect but most legitimate mode of constitutional change
